Event: A, B, C and D. Flights in Singles, Doubles, and Mixed Doubles. Some events might be modified, combined or canceled as necessary.

A events will consist of single-elimination with NO Consolation.

B, C, and D Flight events will consist of single-elimination with consolation.

All matches with the exception of Consolation Matches are run using IBF rules of 15x3 and 11x3 (Women's Singles).

CONSOLATION MATCHES:

All B, C, and D flight consolation matches are played using the 15x1 scoring system with the

exception of Women's Singles using 11x1.

Limit of 2 events per participant per day. More events are allowed with the approval of the tournament director.

Prizes:

Prize money are awarded to winners of A events. Amount is subject to change based on number of entries received for the event.
