Please note Pool play requires significantly more matches. Athletes entering the JITT should be prepared to play many matches each day of competition.
- Seeding: Seeding will be according to normal USAB Junior Seeding procedures. JITT entries and seeding will be posted at <u>www.smashcity.net</u> by Saturday, May 20, 2006. All challenges to JITT seeding must be emailed to Fred Coleman, USAB Junior Committee Chair, at <u>fcoleman@facstaff.wisc.edu</u> by Tuesday, May 23, 2006.
- Draw: The Open Draw for the JITT is scheduled to be done 6pm Thursday, May 25, 2006 at Smash City.
