- I. Schedule for 2010 - Elsie Allen will not have a team
 - A. Preseason marathon Tournament – Stan – Saturday, March 6, 2010
 - B. Have mixed doubles Thur. or Fri., March 11, 2020
 - C. On the Saturday matches you may have to pay a custodian time and a half.
Do not have to have a custodian at Piner.

- II. NBL Qualifying Tournament issues
 - A. It was voted to have the NCS qualifying tournament (Double Elimination) on Saturday, May 15, 2010. (at Piner as they have the most courts).
 - 1) Should we limit the number of entries as we will have 5 tournaments going at once? NCS does not have a double elimination; therefore, it is a shorter tournament. Discuss this at the preseason meeting.
 - 2) Hopefully, we will have at least 5 entries in each category to send onto NCS.
 - 3) ALL SINGLES PLAYERS MUST PLAY IN THE TOURNAMENT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR NCS—even if they have won all their matches at No. 1.

- III. The strongest players do not have to play singles; but the singles players must play in ranked order (6-0-0).
The doubles and mixed doubles teams must play in ranked order.
Players may play in two categories.

- IV. Each coach should have players available to be sure all the players on the opposing team have matches.

- V. NCS Tournament: Saturday, May 22, 2010 at Richmond High School.

- VII. Coaching Education – Every paid or unpaid (volunteer) working with the students MUST TAKE THE COACHING EDUCATION CLASS and be registered with the School District.
Can coach one season without Certification. Must have the certification if you are coaching any sport in any high school in California after the first season.
