Evolution of Bay Area Junior Open

A Northern California Junior Tournament was run by members of the Weller family in Berkeley for several decades. The tournament was professionally run and a great competitive and learning experience in which sportsmanship, etiquette, and adherence to the rules of badminton were emphasized. For various reasons they were forced to halt these valuable tournaments in the early 1990's.

With the help of the Santa Rosa Badminton Club, the tournament was re-introduced in the mid 1990's and events were held in Davis and Santa Rosa. With the support of the South San Francisco Recreation Department this tradition was moved in 1999 to South San Francisco. This first South San Francisco tournament benefited from the new venue, had nearly 90 juniors enter, and was quite successful.

The tradition has continued, and over the years juniors have come from as far away as Seattle, Massachusetts, and of course Southern California to test their skills in the Bay Area Junior Open. Last year's 2002 Bay Area Junior Open was the most successful ever with 245 juniors entering!

Badminton Association of Northern California is proud to continue this tradition of excellence with the 2003 Bay Area Junior Open. The tournament is again scheduled so as to be after the High School badminton season and still well before Junior Nationals. Currently, this year's 2003 Bay Area Junior Open is the last Junior tournament before Junior Nationals.

For High School players, this is a great opportunity to experience Open tournament play, to play in more than just one event, and to continue your enjoyment of Badminton after the High School season has ended.

With the IBF's recent decision, this is expected to be 3x15 with the exception of 3x11 for Womens Singles. Winners of each match must turn in score sheets to the tournament desk, then return to keep score for the next match on that

court.
