In consideration of being permitted to enter for any purpose the premises of MBBC, the undersigned, for himself/herself and personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin, or either of them:

1. Hereby Releases, waives, discharges and covenants NOT TO SUE, MBBC, USABADMINTON or the SCBA their officers and members, all for purposes herein referred to as Releases, from all liability to the undersigned, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin for all loss or damage and any other claims or demands therefore, on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the Undersigned, whether by the negligence of Releases or otherwise while the Undersigned is upon club premises: and.
2. Hereby Agrees to Indemnify and Save and Hold Harmless the Releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur do to the presence of the Undersigned in or about the Club premises and whether caused by the negligence to the Releases or otherwise.
